






ATTENDANCE REMINDERS: IF YOUR CHILD IS POORLY OR GOING TO BE LATE, PLEASE RING THE SCHOOL OFFICE AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE FROM 8AM EVERY DAY THAT YOUR CHILD IS NOT IN SCHOOL.

IF YOUR CHILD NEEDS TO ATTEND AN APPOINTMENT DURING SCHOOL HOURS EVIDENCE OF THE APPOINTMENT IS REQUIRED. WHENEVER POSSIBLE BOOK AFTER SCHOOL

..... SCHOOL PE KIT:
